





Traffic Light Requested for 76th Street and 21st Avenue



I have recently been contacted by area residents requesting that a traffic signal be put up at the intersection of 76th Street and 21st Avenue. Several reasons were cited for requesting this light. Most notably the number of accidents at the intersection, with the most recent one occurring just a few weeks ago. While there are traffic signals on most corners of 21st Avenue, 76th Street is one corner that is without a signal and where most of the accidents have occurred.

On behalf of the community, I contacted the Department of Transportation's Bureau of Traffic and requested that they conduct a feasibility study for installing a traffic signal at this corner. A copy of my letter is on the other side of this note. I am awaiting a response from the Department of Transportation outlining the course of action they plan to take.

I will keep you informed to the status of this request as soon as I receive a response from the Department of Transportation. In the meantime, I will continue to do all that I can to see that our streets are as safe as possible.
