Homeowners, Renters & Small Business Owners You Can Apply For Assistance From FEMA

Federal Emergency Management Agency – Individuals and Households Program

You may be eligible for monetary help if:

- You have filed a claim with your insurance company and the benefits are either insufficient or not available for your situation
- You have necessary expenses or serious needs due to the disaster
- You have accepted assistance from all other sources for which you are eligible
- You or someone who lives with you is a citizen of the United States, a non-citizen national, or a qualified alien

Types of assistance available if you are eligible:

- Housing assistance, including rental assistance and temporary housing
- Other needs such as clothing, medical, or other miscellaneous expenses
- Disaster Unemployment Assistance
- Low interest loans and cash grants
