With the help of the **Assembly Puerto Rican/Hispanic Task Force**, **Assemblywoman Maritza Davila (D - Brooklyn, 53rd AD)**, the **Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of New York** and **Nos Quedamos, Inc.**, Assemblywoman Joyner led a workshop that toured the **Ernesto Ramos Antonini Residential Publico**, a public housing development in Rio Piedras Puerto Rico and the

Boys and Girls Club. Also, Catholic Charities generously donated \$5,000 to the **Cáritas de Puerto Rico's** food pantry, which will feed tens of thousands of families.
