



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What is EPIC?

The Elderly Pharmaceutical Insurance Coverage (EPIC) program is a New York State program for seniors administered by the Department of Health.

Assemblywoman Claudia Tenney voted to restore \$1.2 million to the EPIC program to help seniors afford their medications.

To join EPIC, a senior must:

- Be a New York State resident;
- Have an annual income below \$35,000 if single or \$50,000 if married;
- Be enrolled or eligible to enroll in Medicare Part D (no exceptions); and
- Not be receiving full Medicaid benefits.

The Federal Affordable Care Act will not affect EPIC. New York's commitment to seniors goes beyond the federal government's attempts at reform.
