Dear Friends,

A few statistics speak volumes to the growing influence of Hispanics in our society: approximately 52 million Latinos currently represent 13.5% of the nation's population. Over 17 million are under the age of 18 and 53.5% are under 30 years of age.

This means that a very large number of Latinos are our future students, workers, taxpayers, and business and political leaders. New data on further growth among the U.S. Latino community underscore that the nation's priorities and overall well-being will soon have to reflect the issues that matter to Latinos.

The well-being of Latino children and families can help us create a strong, prosperous and fair nation in which everyone benefits. This prosperity begins with access to a quality education that needs to be complimented with practical and useful workplace experience. Fellowships and internships are great opportunities that can help build leadership and workforce skills absent from a formal k-12 and college education.

In New York and elsewhere, Latinos are dramatically underrepresented in policy making positions in government and the corporate sectors. Although the proportion of Latinos attending college is growing rapidly, only 37.5% of Latino high school graduates have the opportunity to attend colleges and universities. However, only about 50% graduate after 6 years of college. These are problems that negatively impact the economic stability of our communities. As the majority population ages out of the labor force, Latinos should have an opportunity to move into those positions. We must help our youth better prepare for such opportunities. Latino elected officials recognize these trends and are preparing to aggressively address issues of college affordability, access and completion.

The pages that follow are filled with important content that represents sources of funding for college and post-graduate education. In addition, important resources on internships and fellowships are provided for those interested in a career in public service, whether it be work in the government or the non-profit sectors. The Assembly Puerto Rican/Hispanic Task Force is proud to be able to provide this important resource.

It is our hope that this guide will help our youth to better connect with the people, communities and educational opportunities that will provide them with increased opportunities for a successful life. Opportunity and achievement, unhindered, leads to a more informed citizenry that strengthens communities and enriches our entire nation. These are fundamental requirements if we aim to maintain a civil society.

This guide is a tool for empowering lives and communities. On behalf of the Task Force, I hope you find this resource a useful tool that will become part of your library of reference materials.

All internships, fellowships and scholarships require submission of a cover letter and resume.

Many have strict deadlines. Please consider deadlines listed in this directory only as a general guide and check with the program about specific guidelines for the year you are applying, as many programs change their requirements regularly.

Written inquiries are suggested versus phone calls. Several programs, especially fellowships and more selective internships and scholarships, require submission of writing samples, or other specific requirements omitted in this directory/guide. Please make sure to begin your inquiry well before deadlines. Your application will most likely NOT be reviewed if received after the deadline.

While this directory/guide will serve as a very useful resource, it is important to note that there is a large volume of information that has not been included due to space considerations. The websites mentioned above are key to researching more information. Your interest in a specific company or workforce sector can help you narrow your search.
