Working to make it a felony to intentionally interfere with or inhibit a police officer from performing their official duties, including spitting, throwing or spilling items at or on an officer, or pushing, shoving, kicking, physically impeding, or otherwise subjecting such officer to physical contact. (A.8528)



Fighting to make certain offenses against emergency medical services personnel, firefighters, and law enforcement officers as hate crimes; includes the definition of emergency medical services personnel, firefighters, and law enforcement officers. (A.6169)



Presented a bill that creates a police safety equipment grant program of \$30 million to provide for services and expenses related to police safety equipment (A.6387)



Amend the crime of aggravated assault upon a police officer by removing the requirement that the offender must use a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument when intentionally causing serious physical injury to a police officer or peace officer. (A.6402)
