## ASSEMBLYMEMBER JEAN-PIERRE: Delivering for Long Island families

» Nearly **\$3 billion** for child care to expand eligibility for subsidized care and better support working parents



» **\$1.1 billion** for the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) and Landlord Rental Assistance Program (LRAP)



» **\$475 million** for additional Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit payments



» **\$250 million** to help New Yorkers pay back utility bills  
» **\$585 million** to suspend the state gas tax through the end of the year



» **\$35 million** for the Homeowner Protection Program (HOPP) to help New Yorkers at risk of foreclosure stay in their homes



» **\$22 million** for the Hunger Prevention Nutrition Assistance Program



» **\$4.2 million** for the Nutrition Outreach & Education Program (NOEP) to help those facing food insecurity



» **\$3,000 bonus payments** to qualified full-time frontline health care workers and **an increase to the home care worker minimum wage by \$3** over two years
