Introduced the **STAMP OUT FRAUD ACT**, which would implement stricter penalties for insurance fraud, require mandatory investigations, establish advanced fraud detection, and ensure transparency and accountability in combating insurance fraud across New York State. (A.7305)

Looking to **EXTEND** protections for 17-year-olds under the existing “endangering the welfare of a child.” (A.4145)

Fought **AGAINST** the NYS Department of Education’s proposed regulations to regionalize our public schools by authoring the “Our Schools, Our Rules Act,” which would protect the autonomy of our local school districts.¹

Introduced the **NEW YORK STATE ANIMAL JUSTICE ACT**, which would establish the New York State Animal Abuser Registry and provide justice for animals, empower victims, and create the strongest, most comprehensive companion animal protection laws in the United States. (A.9024)

Supported **COMBATING ANTISEMITISM** by strengthening protections against discrimination on college campuses by requiring all colleges and universities to designate a Title VI coordinator. (Chapter 354 of the Laws of NYS 2025)

Voted **AGAINST** the budget proposal that created a \$10 million fund for public officials to use when fighting personal legal challenges. (A.3000-D)

Introduced the **GENETIC PRIVACY AND PROTECTION ACT**, which would ensure that consumer genetic data cannot be treated as a corporate asset to be sold, transferred, or otherwise exploited when a company faces financial distress or bankruptcy. (A.7559)
