





Voted for *INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS*, resulting in \$648 million for roads and highways, an increase of \$50 million from last year. (A.3004-D)

Voted for Daniel's Law pilot programs, which provide \$2 million for a Behavioral Health Crisis Technical Assistance Center to improve **MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS RESPONSE.** (A.3003-D)

Looking to **EXTEND** protections for 17-year-olds under the existing "endangering the welfare of a child." (A.4145)

Fought **AGAINST** the governor's push to potentially delay NY 21's special congressional election for nearly a year.

Support for **EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES** by requiring local governments to develop and maintain county emergency medical system plans that identify existing service gaps and estimate costs for providing such services. (A.8086-A)

**COMBATING ANTISEMITISM** by strengthening protections against discrimination on college campuses by requiring all colleges and universities to designate a Title VI coordinator. (A.5448-B)

Voted **AGAINST** the budget proposal that created a \$10 million fund for public officials to use when fighting personal legal challenges. (A.3000-D, Page 162)

Joined **BI-PARTISAN EFFORT** to keep New York healthy by eliminating synthetic color additives in schools except under certain circumstances (A.8707) and supporting the "food safety and chemical disclosure act" (A.1556).
