SECURING FUNDING FOR PUBLIC TRANSIT



I have been working extensively on improving mass transit for our underserved neighborhoods. Senator Avella and I stood with the Auburndale Improvement Association and the Bayside Hills Civic Association to announce \$500,000 in this year's state budget for a bus service restoration study in Northeast Queens. The MTA will initiate a year-long study of ways to improve bus service and restore recent service cuts in the area, providing relief to our transit starved neighborhoods!
