#### Dear Friends and Neighbors,

There is so much to be grateful for as we close out 2023.

This year, my colleagues in the New York State Legislature passed a \$229 billion budget, allowing us to level the playing field in education and healthcare. We also provided a "clean slate" for returning citizens and re-established New York as a leader in protecting women's right to choose.

In November, three of my bills became law. A.1909 - The Plain Language Bill, which strengthens our democracy by removing legal jargon and increasing readability. A.7677 - The Community Hiring Bill, requires businesses who receive New York City contracts to hire people from zip codes with high unemployment rates. A.1722 exempts non-profit farms and gardens from paying for water to grow the food we count on.

We had some historic wins this year but we aren't done yet! In 2024, we are tackling significant issues related to housing, food security, road safety, and the significant delays in compensating non-profit organizations that are crucial in tackling our community's most pressing challenges.

Our future depends upon our ability to move as a collective and disrupt the silos that sequester us from the rich resources available in our community. Let's step out on faith and connect with entities engaged in the same work to help strengthen our safety net. We can ideate, innovate, and implement solutions that build upon our traditions and preserve our legacy together.

As we look to 2024, let there be peace on earth, and let that peace begin with us.

## **Other Historic Wins!**



Bedford Stuyvesant has its first and only museum with a \$1.5 million investment secured by Assembly Member Zinerman! The Cultural Museum of African Art – Eric Edwards Collection contains over 4,000 artifacts amassed over 50+ years.
