## NYC PROPERTY TAX BENEFITS FOR SENIORS (STAR PROGRAM)

If you're a senior homeowner, the **STAR Program** (School Tax Relief) can help reduce your property taxes. Seniors over 65 who meet income requirements may qualify for **Enhanced STAR**, providing even greater savings on their primary residence.

## NYC SENIOR CITIZEN HOMEOWNERS' EXEMPTION (SCHE)

The **SCHE program** gives seniors a **property tax break** on their home, co-op, or condo if they are 65 or older and meet income limits. It helps make staying in your home more affordable as you age.

#### NEW YORK STATE EPIC (ELDERLY PHARMACEUTICAL INSURANCE COVERAGE)

The **EPIC Program** helps seniors 65 and older pay for prescription drugs. It works alongside Medicare Part D to lower medication costs for those meeting income quidelines.

### ACCESS-A-RIDE (MTA PARATRANSIT SERVICE)

Access-A-Ride provides door-to-door shared transportation for seniors and people with disabilities who cannot use regular buses or subways. It ensures mobility and independence across NYC.
