Assemblymember Glick: Fighting for a healthier New York

To protect our environment, the 2023-24 state budget provides:

-  An all-electric buildings plan to require most new buildings to be powered by electricity instead of fossil fuels beginning in 2026
-  \$400 million for the Environmental Protection Fund
-  \$500 million for clean water infrastructure
-  \$200 million to expand energy affordability programs
-  \$200 million for NYSERDA's EmPower Plus program to provide free energy-efficiency upgrades to income-eligible New Yorkers
