Advocating for the creation of a state volunteer firefighter scholarship program providing student loan relief for volunteers with eight or more years of experience (A.07809)

Working to exempt volunteer firefighter and EMS personnel from vehicle registration fees for vehicles used in the line of duty (A.04239)

Promoting the establishment of a move over law for emergency vehicles flashing blue or green lights to protect them while on calls (A.03826)
