Keeping Communities Safe

Throughout his tenure in the New York State Assembly, Chris has backed the blue and stood up for the men and women who keep us safe. Over the years, Chris has supported legislation that would improve public safety and help officers safely perform their duties, while vocally opposing measures that would make it harder to protect our communities.

Chris is keeping us safe by supporting legislation that will:

- Amend bail reform laws to provide judicial discretion and give judges the ability to determine whether a violent criminal poses a dangerous threat, permitting judges to hold them on bail to keep them off of New York's streets (A.5265).
- Strengthen child endangerment laws and increase penalties for those who sexually abuse children (A.5754).
- Make obstructing a police officer from performing their duties a felony crime (A.4804).
- Create a school resource officer program to allow schools to employ retired law enforcement personnel as school resource officers to keep our kids safe (A.1977).
