**LESSEN THE BURDEN** - Eliminate taxes on fuel, personal care products, housekeeping supplies and ready-to-eat food at grocery stores and restaurants; and gives local governments discretion to eliminate such taxes (A.1690)

**NOURISH MINDS** - Schools to serve breakfast and lunch at no cost to students in public, charter and private schools (A.1941)

**ENSURE ACCESS** - Expand broadband internet access for our rural communities (A.4686)

**MAINTAIN INTEGRITY** - Require voter ID when voting in person or by absentee (A.6111)

**PROVIDE SECURITY** - Create a School Resource Officer Program and establish a resource officer education grant to reimburse schools outside of NYC for the hiring of a school resource officer (A.2023)

**REQUIRE TRANSPARENCY** - Necessitate an explanation by both PSC and NYSEERDA of the state's mandated energy efficiency programs. (A.7263)
