The **Troy Now** Initiative website and application portal is now live! **Read the Full Release**




Mohawk Ambulance Blood Drive

Mohawk Ambulance Service is hosting an upcoming blood drive event on **Tuesday**, **February 15 from 12 – 6:00 p.m., 570 Central Avenue**, **Albany**, **NY**.

The American Red Cross is facing a national blood crisis – its worst blood shortage in over a decade, posing a concerning risk to patient care. With less than a one-day supply of critical blood types in recent weeks, doctors have been forced to make difficult decisions about who receives blood transfusions and who will need to wait until more products become available. The Red Cross is working around the clock to meet the blood needs of hospitals and patients – but can't do it alone. We need your help!

As emergency medical service professionals, Mohawk Ambulance Service is keenly aware how critical blood supply can be in a life-saving situation. Your donations are desperately needed.
