Here's what I am fighting for in Albany:

- **Advocate for stable funding of Community Colleges**
Funding currently changes every year and needs to be based on a 10 year average
- **Increase access to broadband by returning decision making and delegate power to localities.** Only 82.7% of rural households have high-speed internet compared to 98.8% of urban households ¹
- **Amend bail reform to protect our communities**
Public safety issues are an ongoing concern and major crimes rose by 22% in NYC last year ²
- **Give families relief by figuring out how to lower taxes**
Examine personal income taxes and corporate franchise taxes (A.4791)
