## A better future for our children starts with **EDUCATION**

Assemblyman Brian Miller voted to:

- Provide \$25.2 billion, a record amount of aid, for our schools;
- Increase state Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) funding for our college students to \$1.1 billion; and
