

CLEAN WATER, SAFEROADS

All over New York, our highways, bridges, and water infrastructure are crumbling.

That's why Assemblyman Miller delivered:

- > \$200 million for both PAVE-NY and Bridge NY to ensure our families are safe traveling to and from school and work.¹
- Restoration of the \$65 million Extreme Winter Recovery Fund, helping our local municipalities and highway departments restore our roads after harsh winters.²
- Continuation of the \$2.5 billion Clean Water Infrastructure Act, to update drinking and wastewater infrastructure throughout New York.³

And is still fighting for:

- ➤ An increase in Consolidated Local Street and Highway Improvement Program funding of \$100 million, raising it to \$538.1 million.⁴
- Creation of a companion for the CHIPS program, offering financial assistance to local governments for drinking, storm, and sewer water infrastructure, called the Water Infrastructure Investment Program (WIIPS).⁵
