Protecting Our Planet's Future

Assemblyman Magnarelli passed the New York State Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act (Ch. 106 of 2019), which:

- √ S
 - Sets goals to combat climate change, including:
 - reducing greenhouse gas emissions 85% by 2050
 - producing 70% of the state's electricity from renewable energy systems by 2030
 - producing 100% of the state's electricity without emissions by 2040
- ✓ Establishes the New York State Climate Action Council to keep the state on track with its goals
- √ 15% of New York's energy reduction goal can come from projects that rehabilitate the environment, including restoring wetlands, reforestation, or other green projects
- ✓ The act requires the Climate Action Council to create a scoping plan, which
 will set out recommendations for reducing emissions across all sectors of the
 economy, including the transportation, building, industrial, commercial, and
 agricultural sectors



To help clean our neighborhoods and waterways, Assemblyman Magnarelli also banned single-use plastic bags statewide (Ch. 58 of 2019).


