is prioritizing North Tonawanda

Conrad is prioritizing the issues that matter most to North Tonawanda residents:

- **\$5 million for urgent repairs to the city's aging Wastewater Treatment Plant**
 - » These projects will protect basements from flooding and prevent pollution while sparing taxpayers the full fiscal burden.
- **Nearly \$1 million for North Tonawanda city services**
 - » Restoring funding for the Aid and Incentives to Municipalities program provides resources for municipal services and helps keep taxes low.
- **Grants for libraries and museums**
 - » Conrad secured funding for the expansion of the children's area at the North Tonawanda Library and the Herschell Carrousel Factory Museum to assist its student programming.
- **Introduced legislation benefiting Niagara County veterans' organizations**
 - » Conrad's bill, A.9183, allows Niagara County to waive certain fees, like building permit review fees, for veterans' organizations, allowing these groups to maintain or improve their halls, posts and other facilities at a lower cost.
