

As an avid outdoorsman, David DiPietro is a strong supporter of Second Amendment rights. As your assemblyman, he also wants to make sure you are up to date on past and current firearm legislation.

Last legislative session, David voted against what are commonly called the "Red Flag Law" (A.2689) and the "Safe Storage Act" (A.00053) out of concern for motives behind a person "red flagging" another and not having quick enough access to firearms in case of an emergency.

Bills that have been introduced which David is AGAINST in regard to firearms include:



Requiring firearm owners to have a liability insurance policy to cover damages resulting from the use of a firearm. (A.2847)



Establishing a commission to determine what is considered a "personalized pistol." (A.9783)



Enacting the "Handgun Trigger Safety Act" to require key-like items or biometric matches on pistols to control who can shoot them. (A.3258)



Requiring gun manufacturers to place GPS technology into all firearms. (A.8931)



Requiring a person who has "manufactured" or "assembled" a firearm to report the firearm to police to obtain a serial number for the firearm. (A.3152)

Establishing an Ammunition Coding System for all handgun and assault weapon ammunition. (A.3779)
