How We Can Help You!

- Intake and Case Management: Handle incoming inquiries via phone, email, mail, inperson visits, or walk-ins; document constituent concerns about NYS policy, local issues can be referred from intake to resolution.
- Issue Resolution and Advocacy: Assist with common problems such as unemployment claims, housing disputes (e.g., evictions, repairs), public benefits (e.g., SNAP, Medicaid, DOT), veterans' services, or utility bill disputes; advocate by contacting state agencies (e.g., Department of Labor, HCR) on the constituent's behalf.
- Resource Referral and Education: Connect residents to local, state, or federal resources, including non-profits, legal aid, food pantries, or health programs; provide information on Assemblymember-sponsored events, state laws, or eligibility for aid programs.
- **Grants and Letter of Support:** Our office can help in grant processes and can write letters of support for community projects and programs (depending on the program).
- Community Outreach: Attend or organize community meetings and events; distribute educational materials on topics like scam prevention, voter registration, or disaster relief; gather feedback to inform the Assembly Member's legislative priorities.
