Recycling is a fundamental component of New York State's vision of a vibrant, innovative, and sustainable economy. According to the most-recent information available from the United States Environmental Protection Agency, recycling rates have increased from less than 10 percent in 1960 to 34.7 percent in 2015<sup>1</sup>, with approximately 40 percent of those recyclables shipped to China<sup>2</sup>. However, China has significantly restricted the recyclables it will accept, banning some, including post-consumer plastic and mixed paper, and imposing restrictive cleanliness requirements for materials that are accepted. The purpose of this hearing is to examine the status of recycling markets, including the impacts of China's market restrictions, and any potential alternatives that could help reinvigorate New York's recycling efforts.

Persons wishing to present pertinent testimony to the Committee at the above hearing should complete and return the enclosed reply form as soon as possible. It is important that the reply form be fully completed and returned so that persons may be notified in the event of emergency postponement or cancellation.

Oral testimony will be limited to ten minutes' duration. In preparing the order of witnesses, the Committee will attempt to accommodate individual requests to speak at particular times in view of special circumstances. These requests should be made on the attached reply form or communicated to Committee staff as early as possible. Ten copies of any prepared testimony should be submitted at the hearing registration desk. The Committee would appreciate advance receipt of prepared statements.
