



Affidavit in Support of Brooklyn Residency

I, Laurie Chang-Kisacky, make this Affidavit in Support of the Residency of Assembly Member – Elect Lester Chang at the premises located at 1015 E 29th Street, Brooklyn, NY 11210 (hereinafter the “Brooklyn House”):

1. I am the older biological sister of Lester Chang, am a U.S. citizen, and live with my husband in Brooklyn, NY.
2. I am currently employed full-time at Emblem Health as a Medicare Specialist for over twenty years.
3. In the early 1960s, I immigrated to the United States as a child with my parents, May Chang and Kwong Kim Ying Chang, from Hong Kong.
4. My parents worked and subsequently owned a takeout restaurant in Harlem, New York.
5. Lester and my younger biological brother, Wayne Chang, were both born in the Manhattan’s Chinatown in 1961 and 1962, respectively.
6. In 1969, my father passed away at an early age of 59. As a result of financial difficulties and to return my father’s ashes, my mother took her three children to Hong Kong and we lived there for two years.
7. In 1971, my mother returned to New York, found work at Chinese restaurants, and single handedly supported her three children.
8. In 1972, my mother and my uncle, Ping Wah Cheng, pooled their resources together and purchased a two-family house in Midwood Brooklyn, 1015 E 29th Street, Brooklyn, NY 11210 (the “Brooklyn House”), in which my family and uncle lived on the second and third floors and rented the first floor to tenants for many years.
9. I lived at the Brooklyn House from 1972 – 2001, along with Lester and Wayne.
10. Wayne currently resides in Albuquerque, New Mexico, and is employed as a forensic accountant, GS-13, with the U.S. Homeland Security. Wayne also retired from the U.S. Navy Reserve, in July 2022, after 25 years of service.
11. All three of us attended public schools in Midwood, Brooklyn, graduated from Midwood High School, I attended Hunter College, graduated from City College of New York, and Lester and Wayne both attended Brooklyn College.
12. In 1993, after Lester graduated from college and started working for a logistics company, he found an apartment located at 19 Cleveland Place, Apt. 4C, New York, NY 10012 (the “Manhattan Apartment”), and lived there until December 2019.

13. In 1998, both of my brothers Lester and Wayne enlisted in the U.S. Navy Reserve and served twenty-four years and twenty-five years, respectively, until retirement. Both were deployed for active duty in Afghanistan.
14. On September 20, 2000, Lester married Bowie Wong, a logistics manager, and they lived together at the Manhattan Apartment.
15. In 2001, I moved to 15 Clifford Place, Apt. 4L, Brooklyn, NY 11222 after I got married and lived with my husband ever since.
16. In 2011, Wayne moved to Albuquerque, New Mexico, after he got a job with the U.S. Homeland Security as a forensic accountant.
17. My mother and uncle have continuously lived in the Brooklyn House from 1972 to the present.
18. For the past twenty years, Lester and I regularly return to the Brooklyn House to assist our mother due to her advancing age.
19. About ten years ago when my mother turned 85, my visits to the Brooklyn House were more frequent each week in order to assist with her financials, daily hygiene, medical appointments, and shopping, because my mother did not have a home attendant to assist her.
20. On September 9, 2019, Bowie passed away five months after being diagnosed with lung cancer, and Lester and I were at her deathbed at the hospital. Lester was overwhelmed with grief with Bowie's sudden death and eleven days before their 19th anniversary. Bowie's death left a void in Lester's life, he had difficulties coping, and sought grief counseling.
21. For the past three years, Lester had weekly grief counseling and was subsequently diagnosed with PTSD symptoms due to his active deployment in Afghanistan. At my suggestion, Lester started to live at the Brooklyn House to seek solace and comfort to be with our mother.
22. My mother is currently 95 and in frail health, suffers from dementia, and needs daily care and assistance.
23. My uncle is currently 87, in good health for his age, but is legally blind from macular degeneration and he also needs daily care and assistance.
24. Over the past three years, Lester found it difficult to live in his Manhattan Apartment after he lost Bowie and was staying most of the time at the Brooklyn House to alleviate his grief, loneliness, and to be close with our mother and uncle.

25. Lester also assisted me with the care of our mother and uncle's medical appointments, transportation, shopping, hygiene, financial contributions, and home maintenance.
26. During the past three years of the Covid epidemic, Lester was deployed on two separate occasions to support the Covid Mission during 2020, 2021, and 2022, and was deployed at the Javits Center and the Lexington Armory in Manhattan and being quartered at Manhattan hotels by the New York Naval Militia.
27. I can attest that since late 2019, Lester has been living in the Brooklyn House on a regular basis in order to assist me in the care of our mother and uncle, while being treated for his grief and PTSD at the VA Manhattan Medical Center.
28. There is absolutely no question that the Brooklyn House is Lester's residence, and he has maintained his Manhattan Apartment due to the fact that it is rent-stabilized, convenient when he is Manhattan, and he does not want to give up a valuable asset.





Affidavit of Robert L. Morgan III

1. My name is Robert L. Morgan III and my address is 55 East End Avenue Apt. 6K New York, NY 10028.
2. I serve as the political director and the 1st Vice Chair of the Manhattan Republican Party.
3. As a part of my roles in the Manhattan Republican Party, I am tasked with recruiting candidates for public office and occasionally coordinating with the other Republican County organizations to run a slate of candidates on the Republican ballot line.
4. I worked with Lester Chang when he was a candidate for New York State Assembly (2016) and New York State Senate (2020).
5. As part of an effort to support Lester Chang's campaign for State Senate in 2020, I put Lester in touch with the Chairman of the Brooklyn Republican Party, Theodore Ghorra.
6. When Lester Chang attempted to run for New York City Council in 2021, I was part of an effort to remove his name from the ballot because Lester was not endorsed by the Manhattan Republican Party for that office.
7. On or about November of 2021, I attempted to recruit Lester Chang to run for either State Senate or State Assembly in 2022 in Manhattan.
8. During various conversations I had with Lester Chang during November and December 2021, Lester indicated that he needed to decline my offer to run for office in Manhattan because he intended on running for State Assembly in Brooklyn in the 49th Assembly District.
9. During the conversations that I had with Lester in November and December of 2021, regarding his interest in running for office, Lester indicated that he had moved his electoral residence to Brooklyn because he was spending more time there to care for his mother.
10. On or about April of 2022, as part of a ministerial error, the Manhattan Republican Party filed petitions that listed Lester Chang as a candidate for County Committee. The Board of Elections subsequently removed Lester's name from the ballot for the office committee because his electoral residence had already moved to Brooklyn.







Dear Sir,

We are writing this letter to express hundreds of Chinese American voters' opinion for Lester Chang who recent won the election of NYS Assembly District 49. In order to disqualify him, NYS Assembly Speaker challenged his residential status, claimed that he is not a resident in Brooklyn using the so-called "address issue" to overturn the legal election against people's will.

We know Mr. Chang very well for over two years. He went to elementary school and middle school in Brooklyn. He graduated from Midwood HS and Brooklyn College in Brooklyn, NY. When he served our country overseas, his comrades could easily recognize his iconic Brooklyn accent. As a U.S. Navy man for almost a quarter century who usually served abroad around the world, he proudly calls Brooklyn his home, simply because his 95 year old mother has been residing in Brooklyn for half a century. He grew up in Brooklyn with his mother.

When we told people we were going to write a letter for Lester Chang, we asked for peoples' opinion. More than one hundred people expressed their opinion to us. We will quote several from them below:

"Criminals can assault policemen, rob people, and push people into the subway tracks without taking any consequence. We Asian Americans are frequently the victims. We are the fourth class citizens in NYC. Elected officials, from Attorney General to DA, don't care about the victims, and not prosecuting the criminals, because they wanted to get more voters. We have had enough. We needed an Asian American who knows us and represents us."

"It is difficult for my family to make ends meet. My children study hard and we hope education can change their future. However, current elected officials wanted to replace the merit based admission system with a lottery system, this is not fair. I voted for Lester Chang to represent us."

"I am a registered voter, but I was not able to vote on 11/8/2022. If there is another chance to vote in 49th District in the near future, I will vote for Lester Chang."

"My wife and I are U.S. citizens, but when we went to vote on 11/8/2022, we were told that we were not registered. After election, we are now registered to vote. We want our voices heard."

"Lester was elected because of people's will. Asian Americans are waking up now. We will vote for people who represent our community and family values. We are surprised about Lester Chang's residency challenge, and the Assembly does not want to seat him. This is injustice. The people voted for him and he represents our community."

"Now Asian Americans are awakened. From the district map of the NYC election, the red area is where the Asian Americans are located. Because we were discriminated and bullied for too long, we use our votes to support Lester."

"Mr. Chang is well qualified and trusted by the voters that he will represent. The Assembly

challenger says he's not from the community. It's like taking an exam with 60 questions for two hours. One came 20 minutes late, he only had 100 minutes left to take the exam. But he did the best. He should not be disqualified because he was late. Instead, it proved his ability even if he was in an awkward disadvantaged position. Chang won because he earned his voters' trust."

"The NYC Mayor, Eric Adams has a house in Brooklyn, but he has been renting it out for rental income. He lived in New Jersey, while he was Brooklyn borough president and before he moved to NYC Mayor's mansion."

"NYS Senator from Bay Ridge Brooklyn Andrew Gounardes also lives in New Jersey, however, he represents Brooklyn as a Senator. There are three other people in the NYS Assembly who also don't live in their districts."

"NYS Assembly attempted to remove Lester Chang as duly elected 49th district Assemblyman, which will offend all Asian Americans in NYC and completely ruin NYS Assembly reputation and lose the people's trust. If there is another election in 49th district, more and more people will vote for Lester. This time, we predict Lester will lead by 2000 votes compared to the current 600 vote difference."

He expressed that the role helped him personally – in dealing with the grief he was suffering from the loss of his wife by having the support of his family at home, while simultaneously providing support to his elderly mother and family members.

(5) The Brooklyn Republican Party held candidate screenings in February 2020 for, among other seats, the NYS Senate District 26 seat for which Mr. Chang had expressed an interest. At this meeting, prior to the formal portion of the session, we (Mr. Chang included) briefly discussed the possibility of him running in Brooklyn in the future should this 2020 election not prove successful for him, given his long ties to the borough and his ongoing transition back to Brooklyn.

(6) In or about late September / early October 2021 I had discussions with Mr. Morgan about running Mr. Chang in Brooklyn for a NYS Legislative seat in the 2022 election, given that his current primary residence appeared to be in Brooklyn. I had a follow-up discussion with Mr. Chang regarding same during this time period, and inquired (to re-confirm) about where he was primarily living, the care he was giving to his mother and whether he would have time to run for office given possible time constraints around both his possible ongoing military service and familial obligations. Mr. Chang acknowledged his interest in running for political office and confirmed that while he was not present at the Jacob Javits Convention Center (military related) or elsewhere for work, he spent the supermajority of his time caring for his elderly mother and living in his Brooklyn home.

(7) Subsequently, in the fall of 2021, Mr. Robert Morgan and I once again discussed various candidates for the following year's elections, the possible NYS redistricting changes that would be forthcoming, the current and possible shared Manhattan and Brooklyn districts, as well as the very real likelihood that Mr. Chang would run for office in Brooklyn based on prior discussions, and the reality that his residence was in Brooklyn at this time.

(8) In February 2022, the Brooklyn Republican Party held candidate screenings for, among other seats, Assembly District 49, at which Mr. Chang was interviewed by the

Brooklyn Republican Party. More than ample signatures were obtained and the qualifying petitions were filed with the NYC Board of Elections in a timely manner.

(9) To my knowledge, these petitions were not challenged in 2022 at the Board of Elections or in any court having jurisdiction over such matters, unlike both (1) 45th AD Assemblyman Cymbrowitz' failed board and court challenge to Assemblyman-elect Michael Novakhov's qualifying petitions and (2) Assemblywoman Helene Weinstein's successful board challenge of the Republican candidate for Brooklyn's Assembly District 41.


(10) In November 2022, Mr. Chang was elected by the constituents of the 49th Assembly, and his election was certified by the NYC Board of Elections on December 2, 2022.
