That's why the NYS Legislature passed bills expanding early voting options and simplifying voter registration.



You can register, re-register and make address changes at many state and local offices serving the public, including the departments of Labor, Social Services and Motor Vehicles, as well as state and city universities.

Sixteen- and 17-year-olds can pre-register and will be able to vote in person or apply for an early mail voting ballot or absentee ballot once they turn 18 on or before Election Day.



Any registered voter in New York, including pre-registered individuals who will be 18 years old by Election Day, may apply to vote early by mail. Visit **elections.ny.gov/request-ballot** for more information and to apply for an early mail voting ballot.



The state Board of Elections will automatically transfer the voter registration information of any New Yorker when it receives a notice of change of address to another address in New York State and will inform the voter when that notice has been received.


